What data do we collect?

www.pillars-of-health.eu collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (e.g. Name, email address, organisation)
- Technical data from equipment such as IP address (not linked to individual persons) in cookies and website tracking data (Google Analytics)
- How do we collect your data?
- You directly provide www.pillars-of-health.eu with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:
 - Fill in and submit the 'Join us' form to join the Pillars of Health coalition.
 - Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

www.pillars-of-health.eu collects your data so that we can:

- Process your registration to join the Pillars of Health coalition.
- Get in touch with you to set up an introduction call.

How do we store your data?

www.pillars-of-health.eu securely stores your data at Wemos Foundation (Ellermanstraat 15-O, 1114 AK, Amsterdam-Duivendrecht, The Netherlands).

What are your data protection rights?

www.pillars-of-health.eu would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request www.pillars-of-health.eu for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that www.pillars-of-health.eu correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request us to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that www.pillars-of-health.eu erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that www.pillars-of-health.eu restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to www.pillars-of-health.eu processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that www.pillars-of-health.eu transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our website, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

www.pillars-of-health.eu uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

Functionality - www.pillars-of-health.eu uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include the completed fields in the 'Join us' form for the coalition. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.

Statistics cookies - These cookies collect information about how you use a website, like which pages you visited and which links you clicked on. None of this information can be used to identify you. It is all aggregated and, therefore, anonymized. Their sole purpose is to improve website functions. This includes cookies from third-party analytics services as long as the cookies are for the exclusive use of the owner of the website visited.

How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.

Privacy policies of other websites

www.pillars-of-health.eu contains links to other websites. Our privacy policy applies only to our website, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy policy.
